***Topic: FDA and Ortho-McNeil Announce Voluntary Recall of Griseofulvin Oral Suspension Medication for the Treatment of Fungal Infections.***

Recently, Ortho-McNeil and FDA announced a nationwide voluntary recall of griseofulvin oral suspension, a prescription medication used to treat ringworm and other fungal infections. The recall was issued based on two reports of glass fragments found in bottles of the liquid formulation. The recall is limited to the liquid formulation of the medication and does not include any other dosage form. Patients that may have the medication should contact the pharmacy where they purchased the drug to determine if they have the product that has been recalled.
